Bearcats Baseball Team Promises to “Start Trying” Two Years After New Stadium Is Built

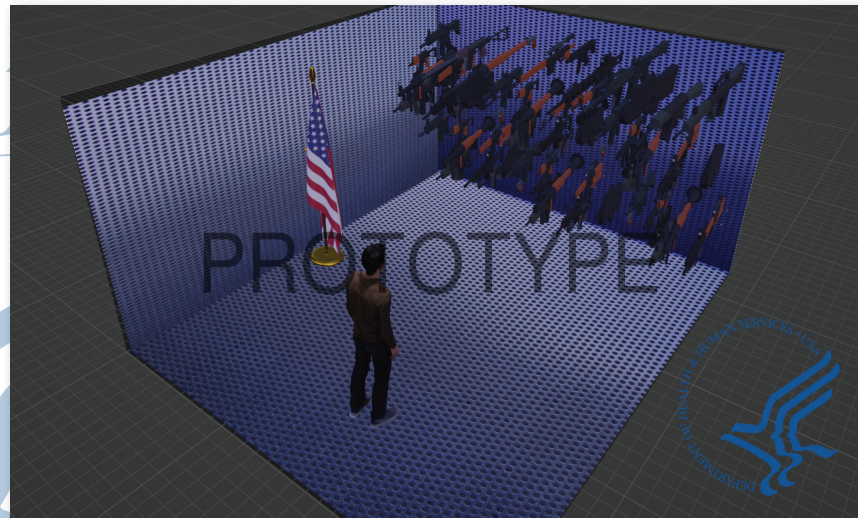

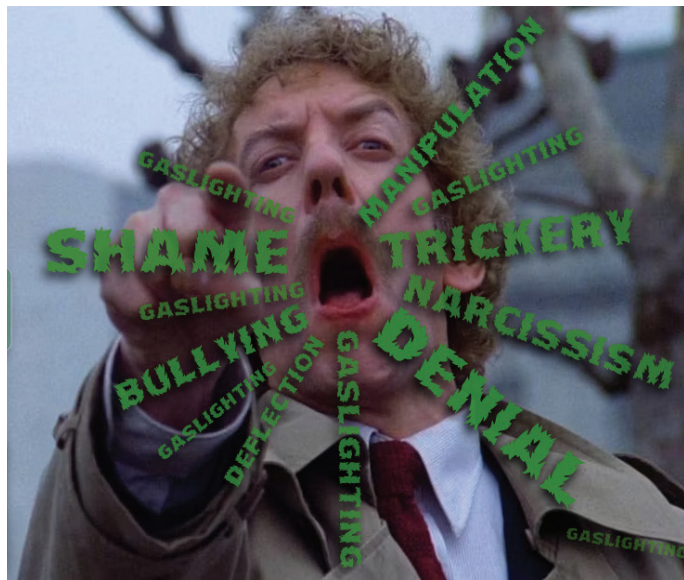
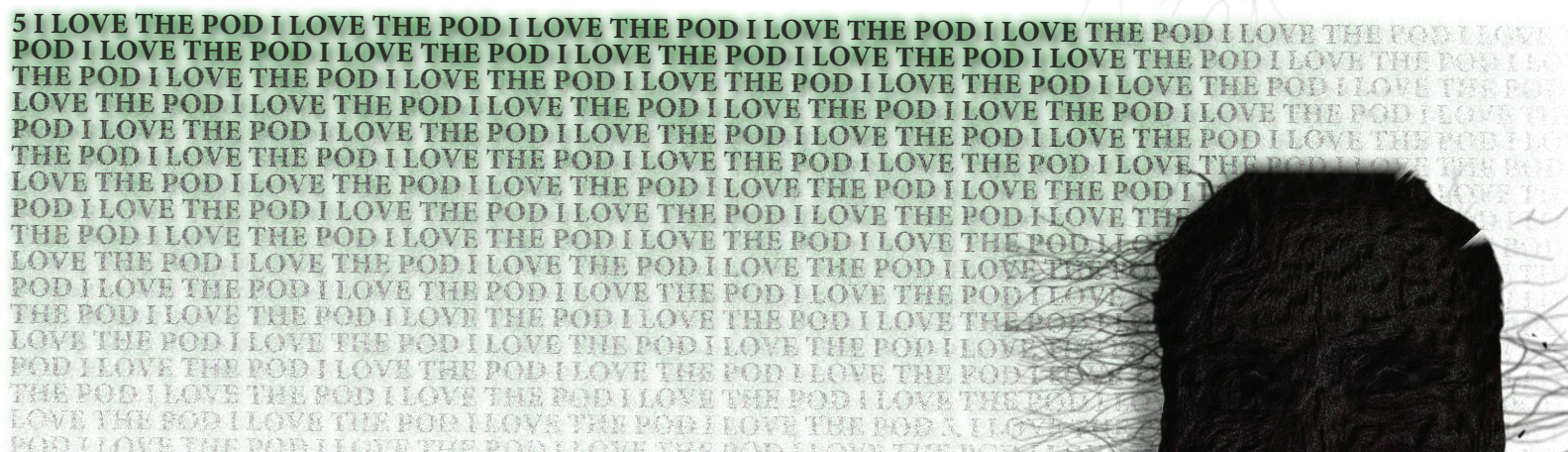
3. They force you to tuck in their "green therapy bag"

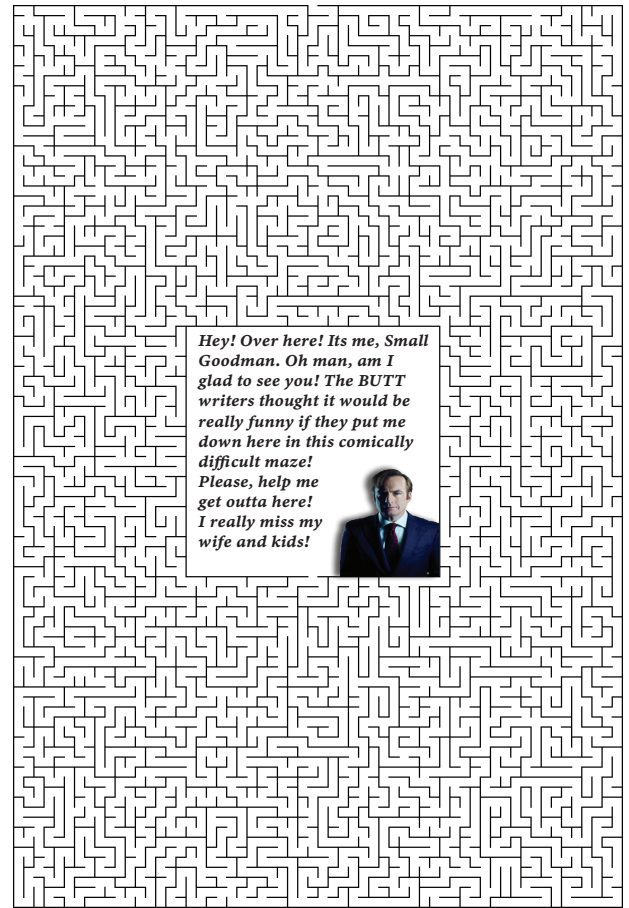

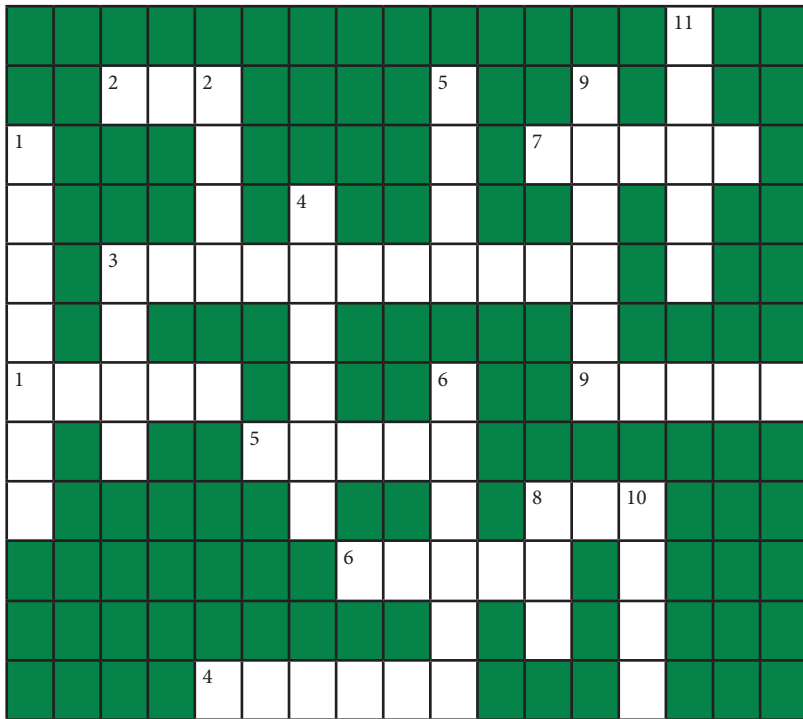

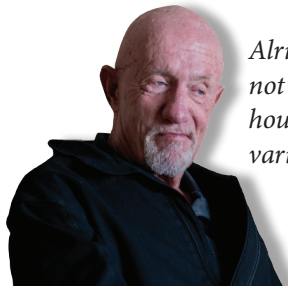
